

CARPENTERS CLUB

Want to help with Watauga County Habitat for Humanity but just can't find the time? The Carpenter's Club allows you a way to participate without the need to rearrange your schedule.

The Carpenter's Club was founded at our affiliate in 2004 by Lori Nicklin as a way to allow people to contribute funds to Habitat for Humanity on a regular basis. This club is for those who are unable to volunteer time at the building site or as a committee member yet has the desire to be involved in the building of affordable, decent homes in Watauga County in another way.

This portion of the organization raises money through pledges made by the individuals that are collected at the completion of a home. A reminder is sent out to the individual contributors to notify them of the home completion. The pledges collected from the completed home are used to fund the next home. All donations are tax deductible and a letter of gratitude is sent with a donation receipt to each club member when their pledge donation is received at the affiliate office.

There is no set limit on pledges and the amount pledged is determine by each individual belonging to the club. The Carpenter's club, through community generosity, on average raises between \$11,000.00 and \$14,000.00 per completed home to support the funding of homes built by Watauga County Habitat for Humanity.
